### FLORIDA SUPREME COURT CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Florida Supreme Court County Mediator Certification is based on a point system. All persons applying for certification as a Florida Supreme Court Certified County Mediator are required to accumulate 100 total points with a minimum of 30 points to be awarded for successful completion of the applicable Florida Supreme Court Certified County Mediation Training Program. Successful completion of the applicable Florida Supreme Court Certified County Mediation Training Program requires the attendee to be in attendance for the entire course. No exceptions will be granted for this requirement. An additional 10 points may be awarded to the applicant for education and previous mediation experience. The remaining 60 points must be obtained through the applicant's mentorship experience. An applicant must have a minimum of a high school diploma or GED. **YOU DO NOT NEED ANY LEGAL TRAINING TO BECOME A FLORIDA SUPREME COURT COUNTY MEDIATOR. ALL INTERESTED PARTIES ARE WELCOME TO ATTEND THE TRAINING COURSE.**
